Wheeling and Feed-In Tariffs

- There are currently 4 wheeling agreements signed by CoE all belonging to one customer. The Solar plant is currently under construction in the Free State Province for these wheeling agreements.
- The CoE billing department has not yet completed testing the feed-in tariffs on the new billing system however they hope to conclude this before the end of this year. Any customer with a registered embedded generator can participate in the program once activation is live. Please see Attachments.
